Hazardous Waste Transporter Fees

N.J.A.C. 7:26G-3.3(f)1 provides that, except for new hazardous waste transporter applicants, any hazardous waste transporter that collects or delivers hazardous waste within the State shall pay an annual fee that is the greater of either the per ton fee codified at N.J.A.C. 7:26G-3.3(f)1 or the supplier (see N.J.A.C. 7:26G-3.3(f)2 and 3). the initial five, at a per decal cost pursuant to the contract awarded by the Department to its decal waste transporters are required to pay the minimum fee plus the actual cost of each decal beyond based on program costs.
